A really depressing set of statistics, in that there is still no sign of recovery and in fact the passenger figures (excl Transit) are the worst Year on Year since June 2009 at -11.7%. The freight figures compared to Nov 2008 are also down by 11.5%, which is very similar to last months. The passenger numbers for T2 (312,484) are lower than T3 (330,189), which is hasn't happened for a long time, and it is possibly the first time it has happened. The Moving Annual Total (Incl Transit) is very close to falling below the 19 million mark, which last occurred in 2002.
